

MWRD'S IICP SHORT TERM REQUIREMENTS DUE SOON!



Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago's (MWRD) Inflow & Infiltration Control Program (IICP) short term requirements deadline is quickly approaching. **Tributary municipalities that own and/or operate a separate sanitary sewer system which discharges into MWRD facilities must develop short term requirements by July 2019.**

MANDATORY ACTIONS

SHORT TERM REQUIREMENTS DUE JULY 2019!

1. Assess condition of critical locations within public separate sewer systems and rehabilitate major defects by 2020.
2. Develop Private Sector Program (PSP) for long term implementation.
3. Develop a Long Term Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Program (LTOMP).
4. Develop CIP for high priority deficiencies.

LONG TERM 5+ YEARS

1. Implement Private Sector Program.
2. Utilize industry standard asset management tools such as GIS Mapping.
3. Continue ongoing sewer inspection, maintenance, cleaning and rehabilitation.
4. Develop BB and SSO Emergency Response Program.
5. Commit to annual system maintenance.

FUNDING & TIPS

TIP: IEPA and other agency application and approval processes may take valuable time, so start assessments as soon as possible to take advantage of available funding programs.

Funding:

- IEPA – SRF funding is available to all communities within the MWRD corporate limits.
- MWRD may provide funding for I/I removal and rehabilitation subject to Public Act 90-0690.
- Municipalities can also use local funds from service fees and annual CIP budgets.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS . . .

Q When must I have my Private Property and LTOMP complete?

A We recommend completing your Private Sector Plan and LTOMP between January-June 2019.

Q My community has not done any MWRD IICP work. Is that a problem?

A Your community is behind others, but you have until July 2019 to come into compliance. We can help you get there.

Q I don't know what to budget for FY2019 and FY2020. Can you help?

A Yes, we can help you assess your current compliance status and develop a plan and budget for short term and long term requirements.

Q I heard that there is only one engineering firm that assisted develop the IICP program, works directly with MWRD, and knows all the requirements. Is that true?

A No. A handful of firms were involved with the planning and are working with MWRD staff. Baxter & Woodman and RMS assisted 20+ MWRD satellite communities combined meet the requirements.

Q If my community has been working on the IICP requirements internally or with another consultant, is it OK to switch firms?

A Yes, we can quickly assess what has been done to date and begin helping with remaining program needs.
